You shall not lose anything this month. It shall be a month of supernatural recovery, in the Name of Jesus.

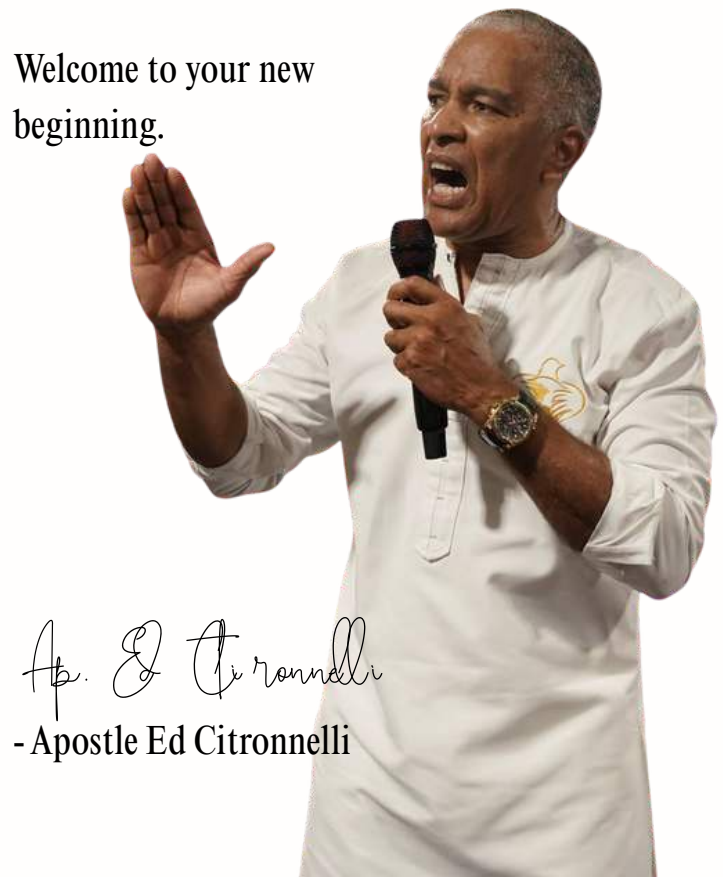
You are standing at the door of breakthrough this month. Whatever bad news you have received for the first seven months, I see that bad news changing. It's becoming good news.

I SEE THE TONGUE OF THE ENEMY BEING SILENCED.

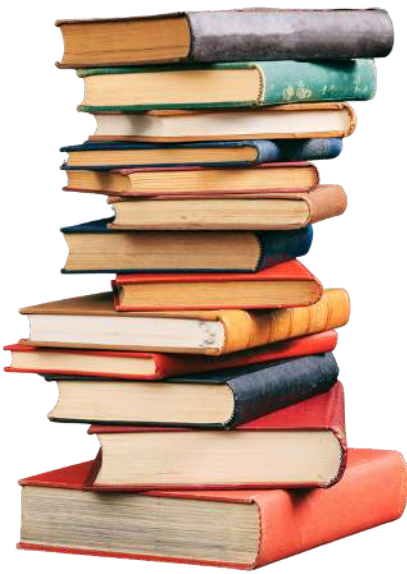

LOVE THE LORD WITH ALL YOUR LEARNING

What the enemy has tried to frame as a burden and chore is actually an invitation to deeper revelation of the nature and character of God

Tuesday, August 4, 2026

August in America is the signal that the lazy days of summer vacation and school break have come to an end. Here in Texas and throughout the southern United States, it is the month that kicks off the school year. Many northern states follow not too far behind with early September return dates. For parents, it can mean expensive school supply lists, weekday lunches that need to be made, sports practices, school pick-up lines, and the end of summer's freedom. For students, it can mean homework, book reports, and a return to the "grind." But what if I told you that what the enemy has tried to frame as a burden and chore is actually an invitation to deeper revelation of the nature and character of God?

The Bible is not a book of folklore and mere ancient wisdom—although some modern institutions teach it as such. It is a book of history. Filled with the accounts of actual people, actual events, and actual encounters with a true and living God. It is filled with wisdom, yes, but it is also filled with absolute truth and divine insight into every area of human life. Including—you guessed it—academics.

Scripture paints a picture of both a God and an ancient world that value learning, wisdom, and the observance of protocols. People were esteemed highly if they had a handle on all three of those areas. In fact, in order to be a leader in the ancient world, you needed to be intelligent but also well-versed in the ways of the land you wanted to lead. Long before Google and ChatGPT, people had advisers, wise men, and scribes ready to record events, recall information, and give advice from both their minds and the spiritual realm.

When Pharaoh had two disturbing dreams that he did not understand, *“he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt and all its wise men.”* (Genesis 41:8) A few generations later, when Moses and Aaron would confront the oppressive ruler of Egypt, that Pharaoh called for his wise men (Exodus 7:11). After asking the Lord for an understanding heart (1 Kings 3:9), Scripture explains that God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding, and that *“Solomon’s wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the men of the East and all the wisdom of Egypt. For he was wiser than all men.”* (1 Kings 4:29-30) *“And men of all nations, from all the kings of the earth who had heard of his wisdom, came to hear the wisdom of Solomon.”* (1 Kings 4:34)

Wisdom, understanding, counsel, and knowledge aren’t only important to the Lord; they are expressions of His Spirit. They are part of His divine nature. Look at Isaiah 11:1-2:

*There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse,
And a Branch shall grow out of his roots.
The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him,
The Spirit of wisdom and understanding,
The Spirit of counsel and might,
The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.*

Proverbs 4:7 tells us, *“Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding.”* Proverbs 9:10 tells us, *“The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.”* These things are not only invaluable, but inseparable.

They can be divinely bestowed, as it says in Proverbs 2:6, but they can also be gained through learning, observation, and meditating on the Word of God. With all of that in mind, the back-to-school season takes on a new significance. Framed with the understanding of how important learning and knowledge are to our heavenly maker, the scales fall from our eyes, and we see that it is the beckoning of the Spirit of the Lord to come up higher and an opportunity for elevation into spheres of influence and leadership.

This is true for all of us.

In the Kingdom, every experience, lesson learned, and piece of training has the potential to become a weapon in the hand of the Lord. God wants to use all of us for His Glory. *“For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.”* (Ephesians 2:10)

The deposit that heaven has made in each of us is valuable, and value is meant to be stewarded. Consider the parable of the talents recorded in Matthew 25:14-30. One servant was given five talents, another servant was given two talents, and another servant was given one talent. Each was given to steward according to their ability. A talent wasn’t merely a shekel or a coin. It was a weight used for monetary exchange—and a large one at that! Its exact equivalent varied across time and place, but it is widely understood that a single talent was considered a small fortune to many and represented more money than many in the audience had or would ever handle.



Increase comes when we manage what we have already been given well. Advancement in academics is good stewardship of information and knowledge. Mastering skills when we are presented with the opportunity to improve is good stewardship. Even actions as simple as honoring instructors by being on time, listening well, and turning in assignments demonstrate good stewardship. Studying demonstrates good stewardship. And stewardship opens doors.

When God was giving Moses the blueprint for governing the nation of Israel, He did more than dictate a simple set of commands (see Exodus 31:1-11). He began to identify those whom He had chosen to fill specific roles and execute certain responsibilities. The design for building the tabernacle was detailed, but there were people who had been divinely endowed and also clearly trained in the skills that it took to execute those building plans. *“See, I have called by name Bezalel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah. And I have filled him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship,”* (Exodus 31:2-3) the Lord said to Moses. *“And I, indeed I, have appointed with him Aholiab the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan; and I have put wisdom in the hearts of all the gifted artisans, that they may make all that I have commanded you.”* (Exodus 31:6)

The Bible doesn’t say that Bezalel, Aholiab, or the artisans suddenly woke up with the ability to create the things that the Lord required for the tabernacle. Instead, we are given the picture that these were hardworking, well-taught individuals who, by the enablement of God, were the best of the best at what they did. In fact, the word translated as gifted describing the artisans can also be translated as skillful.

What skills, talents, and abilities is the Lord empowering you to develop? Whatever your ability, whatever your skill, steward it well.

Some of the most well-known Biblical figures submitted to intense seasons of learning. The testimonies of Daniel and the three Hebrew boys didn’t happen only because they acted in faith. They were prisoners of war who had learned the language, culture, and laws of an enemy territory and then stepped into leadership within its systems.

After they had been taken captive, Nebuchadnezzar called for *“young men in whom there was no blemish, but good-looking, gifted in all wisdom, possessing knowledge and quick to understand, who had ability to serve in the king’s palace, and whom they might teach the language and literature of the Chaldeans.”* (Daniel 1:4) These four fit the bill and were assigned food from the king’s table and *“three years of training for them, so that at the end of that time they might serve before the king.”* (Daniel 1:5)

“God gave them knowledge and skill in all literature and wisdom; and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams.” (Daniel 1:17) They turned out to be the best of the best. *“And in all matters of wisdom and understanding about which the king examined them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians and astrologers who were in all his realm.”* (Daniel 1:20)

It was this season of their lives, and the decision to lean into their God-given graces to learn, that positioned the four to step into leadership in Babylon. Once positioned, the hand of the Lord continued to move through and upon them in supernatural ways that brought God glory. For Daniel, those three years opened the way to over six decades of advisement to the royal court. What if they hadn't taken the three years of learning seriously?

Even Jesus submitted to the process of learning. He was the Word made flesh, yet in Luke 2, we see the child, Jesus, *“in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions.”* (Luke 2:46) In the same chapter, we see him honoring the written law of Moses and submitting to his parents (Luke 2:51). The Lamb of God who was slain before the foundation of the world loved the world enough to be born into. He learned to eat, to talk, and to walk. He built relationships. He had childhood friends. He learned the trade of his earthly father—carpentry. All the while, being God. All the while knowing that the cross was coming. He went in love when the time arrived.

“If you love me, keep my commandments,” (John 14:15) Jesus told the disciples during the last supper. The greatest commandment is to love the Lord with all of our heart, soul, and mind (Matthew 22:37-38). Taking this semester, school year—or any learning opportunity for that matter—seriously is an offering that pleases the Lord. As you head into this back-to-school season, endeavor to love the Lord with all your learning and to use what you've learned to serve others.

JEHOVA RAPHA

CLINIC DISHES OUT BREAD OF DELIVERANCE



July 25, 2026

(Arlington, TX) Seated at a white café table, in his signature, all white, Apostle Ed Citronnelli, founder of World Healing Church, appeared relaxed as he explained the scriptural basis for the believer's need for deliverance. Before him sat twenty people who had made the commitment to the spiritual journey of recovery via the Rapha Clinic. The event was a two-day, intensive deliverance cohort and was the first of its kind for the ministry. Hosted at World Healing Church's Arlington campus, attendees were welcomed into the

Freedom Arena for an intimate time of worship and teaching. However, for this occasion, the intimate setting and atmosphere of the Milk & Honey Café proved to be exactly what the doctor ordered for the group.

The ministry is known for multi-day trainings in the areas of spiritual warfare and deliverance. Rapha Clinic was a rare boot camp in both, with a focus on practical application of spiritual keys and presented accessibly to allow attendees to identify areas where they are in need of deliverance.

Running full throttle with the "clinic" theme and visuals, attendees were met by staff and volunteers dressed in full medical scrubs. They then completed the necessary paperwork in the form of intake forms to allow the deliverance team to determine the best course of spiritual care for them.

Though the ministry is known for deliverance, private sessions are mostly a rare occurrence due to demand and logistics. Rapha Clinic was different. A crucial element of the event was the individual deliverance session, facilitated in closed-door settings with no cameras present. The ministry, with more than 500,000 subscribers on YouTube, regularly has videos go viral for video clips and demonstrations of the delivering power of the Holy Spirit. For followers of the ministry, this is a sought-after opportunity.

On the origins of Rapha Clinic, Apostle Citronnelli recounts receiving the instructions from the Lord to organize the event: “During that prayer and fasting time, I heard the word ‘rapha’. Now, I sat there to understand what that really meant. And that's where the clinic came in. He said, ‘Why don't you put together a time when people will come, like a clinic, and call it Rapha? For the purpose of that clinic would be for healing, delivering emotionally—as well, inner healing — and everything that's connected to healing because that's who I am.”

God declares Himself as Jehovah Rapha in Exodus 15:26, saying to the children of Israel, “*For I am the Lord who heals you.*” Healing is therefore a promise of God in Scripture. The Word of the Lord that was released over 2026 through Apostle Citronnelli announced 2026 as the Year of YHWH—A Year of Promises Fulfilled. Biblically spurred on by the account recorded in Genesis 26:18-26, this year, perhaps more than in those prior, the church and Ed Citronnelli Ministries have been expanding the types of events that they host. There was an emphasis on in-depth leadership trainings in the first part of the year, a shift in the methodology of out-of-state events, and now, the addition of an entirely new type of event.

One of the key teachings from day one—the sinful nature of man and the need for deliverance that every human being has—was well illustrated by the diversity of backgrounds, spiritual maturity, and needs among

the group. “We have had a vast difference in attendees,” explained David Ahart, Associate Pastor of World Healing Church and a crucial team member for Ed Citronnelli Ministries. “We have people here that have been saved one week. We have people here that have been saved for 30 years that are attending. And each of them have various needs. And we have people from the most basic—secular needs coming straight out of the world system. And then we have others who have experienced church hurt and offense.”

Throughout the event and into day two, the intimate setting of the Milk & Honey Café created an atmosphere of safety and informality. Times of teaching gave way to deep discussions as attendees asked questions and shared stories as they began to connect their personal experiences to the topics being discussed. “It's made them aware of



where they've allowed the enemy in and what they need to do to keep the doors closed,” explained Pastor Ahart. “So, there is a high expectation today as we're going into the personal ministry time.”

There was seriousness and palpable expectation in the room as the time for personal ministry came. Left to their own faith, many of the participants gathered in groups to

pray and focus their attention on the Lord. One by one, they were called away for times of personal healing and deliverance. And, one by one, they returned to the Milk & Honey Café different in ways that were evident, yet not easily explained.

The mood inside the room very quickly shifted from one of unspoken anxiety to one of rejoicing and anticipation. People stepped through the café doors, appearing lighter. The eyes of some sparkled. Some were crying. At least one was led back by a volunteer clinician, shaking and bewildered after being touched powerfully by the power of God. “I loved seeing people go into their deliverance and coming out completely different,” said Jocelyn M., E-commerce Resource Manager for Ed Citronnelli Ministries. “I saw a man come in very—just looked very unhappy. And, when he came out after his deliverance session, I saw nothing but smiles and happiness.”

After facilitating several hours of closed deliverance sessions, Apostle Citronnelli emerged from the sanctuary like a surgeon who had just been used to work miracles. Standing tall and steady, his skin appeared sticky with the dew of perspiration. No doubt, the ministry of conflict and violence — as Apostle refers to it — had just been rendered with precision. On his white scrubs, a lone, thumb-sized makeup stain was the only other visible sign of the spiritual battle that had just ensued.

Speaking on the event, Apostle Ed shared:

“Rapha Clinic has been a time like no other. It was unique; it was different; and it was the first time that we have ever done this in the history of Ed Citronnelli Ministries. The intent of Rapha was not just to get the people delivered, even though they got that... The ultimate goal was to equip them with knowledge based on the Word of God so that they can both (a) sustain their deliverance through knowledge. And then help others get delivered through the same knowledge that they themselves received.”

As the group gathered together on Saturday evening to close out the Rapha Clinic, victory and divine satisfaction ruled. An awareness of the love of God and gratitude for His faithfulness were felt and expressed as the group settled into the lived reality of having just experienced deliverance. YHWH had kept His promise.

Over two thousand years later, Christ Jesus, who ascended into heaven and is currently seated at the right hand of the Father, still saves. The man from Galilee who healed the woman who had been bleeding for twelve consecutive years still heals (Mark 5:25-34; Matthew 9:20-22; Luke 8:43-48). Jesus, who, when He stepped out of a boat and onto the region of



Gadarenes, set free a man who had been tormented by a legion of demons, still delivers (Mark 5:1-20). Once he had been restored, Jesus told the man from Gadarenes, *“Go home to your friends, and tell them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He has had compassion on you.”* (Mark 5:19) And the man did exactly that. For the attendees of Rapha Clinic, the expectation is the same.

Having received teaching and freedom, it is time for the attendees to live out Jesus’bold declaration of Isaiah’s prophecy in Luke 4:18-19:

*“The Spirit of the Lord is upon them,
because He has anointed them
To preach the gospel to the poor;
He has sent them to heal the brokenhearted,
To proclaim liberty to the captives
And recovery of sight to the blind,
To set at liberty those who are oppressed;
To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.*

“I believe that what the people got this weekend was not just for now,”shared Apostle Citronnelli,“But it's for them to carry for the rest of their lives. And [for] everyone else that they will come in contact with.”

This weekend in Arlington, Texas, YHWH kept His promises. Jehovah Rapha, healed. The event was sealed with a Sunday celebration service and the bestowing of certificates to participants.

SPOILS OF WAR SPARK HEALING AND FAITH AT NORTH TEXAS CHURCH

“I DIDN’T THINK I WAS GOING TO GET DELIVERANCE, BUT I DID!”

Those are the words of Mary T., who attended Freedom Night at World Healing Church in Arlington, Texas on Friday, July 31st. What some may have expected to be just another church service turned out to be the day of emancipation for at least one North Texas family. Mary and her daughter Imelda had visited the Freedom Arena in the past, but neither had been in a while. Seated on the front row, the unassuming duo was positioned by heaven to receive the benefits of the cross.

Taking the platform at the end of worship, Apostle Ed Citronnelli, founder of World Healing Church and Host of Freedom Night, set the tone for the evening. “I want you to say one word with me. This is going to establish what you get out of this night. And, in fact, for the rest of your life. Are you ready? Look at three people and tell them, ‘Expect what Jesus promised He would do.’ Tell t



hem, ‘Expectation tonight is the word.’”

This was more than a simple exhortation. Something had shifted in this seasoned leader of the faith. During the Fanning the Flame prayer meeting the evening prior, the Word of the Lord had landed like a bomb. Apostle Ed addressed the group with excitement, but in a measured, contemplative tone as if he were still processing the very thing that he was explaining. What happened for Mary, her daughter Imelda, and many others was an aftershock.

“Expect it, expect it, expect it,” the Voice of the Lord had declared in the prayer meeting. “In My Kingdom: you expect it, you receive it. You wait for it, you will get it... Expecting something is receiving in motion of that something. Expect it. Your expectation puts it in motion.”

Stepping into Freedom Night, that expectation was on full display in the front of the sanctuary. Empty wheelchairs were on the platform. Canes, walkers, and crutches were leaning against it. These weren’t



medical artifacts. They were testimonies of healing from crusades past. Spoils of war, as Apostle Ed referred to them, brought back as memorial stones of miracles and moments of God’s power made manifest. Picking up two of the canes, Apostle Ed noted his remembrance of where they had come from, emphasizing that their original owners did not leave the meeting with their conditions. They had been set free.

“As you can see, this person also did not go back with their problem,” he said, placing the second cane down. “Jesus is a healer. I said, Jesus is a healer. He’s a deliverer. And He’s

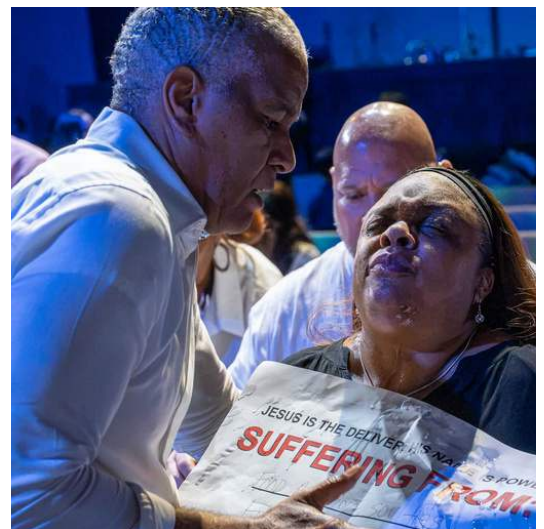
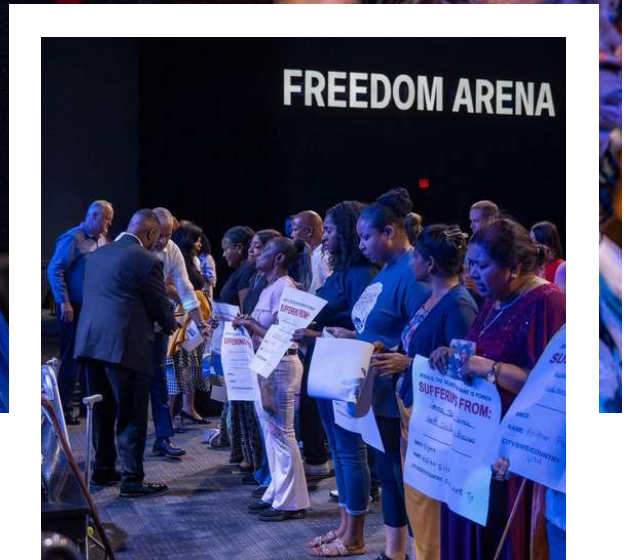
here tonight.” This marked a transition in the gathering.

Apostle Ed began to lead the room in making a personal decree that abruptly gave way to the word of knowledge for healing. “Bones. Bones. Bones. Circulation, I’m hearing also. Get out of your seat and come up now. You see, we don’t have to have a crusade to heal the sick. Let’s just heal the sick in the Name of Jesus. He said, ‘In My Name, go and do it.’”



Out of their seats, the people came with pain and ailments —pinched nerves, numbness, painful circulation, and more—all publicly acknowledged before they were ministered to. When asked how long they had been experiencing these physical difficulties, the numbers were sobering. Five years, six years, two years, twenty years. All too long in the light of the Gospel.

“How can we be in church worshiping God, when He said, ‘I am the God that healeth thee,’ and we’re not healed?” Apostle Ed asked, bothered by the plight of the believers who stood before him on the ministry line. After a brief exhortation on the imperativeness of keeping speech and thinking aligned with the spiritual reality of received



healing, quick work was made of the ministry line. The power of God was on display as people fell and shook under the working of the Holy Spirit.

“If I laid hands on you, begin to check yourself. How do you know if He did it or not?” Apostle Ed challenged as the altar cleared. Noticing Mary T. in the front, her face still wet with water from the healing line, he extended the microphone to her, asking about what she was experiencing.



“I used to hurt when I got up, and I didn’t feel nothing,” she said, giving the congregation and Apostle Ed cause for celebration. Catching up with her after the service, Mary expanded on her experience:

“I didn’t think I was going to get deliverance, but I did. Because I couldn’t walk. I walk with a cane, but I forgot it. And so, I’m so happy that I came, because I got deliverance and I don’t hurt no more. I mean, I couldn’t even walk. I couldn’t even get up, you know? When I’m on the floor, it takes me a long time to get up because it hurts me a lot. But. I feel delivered.”

Mary’s daughter Imelda was also powerfully touched by the Lord in the service.



“I felt like I was trapped. I felt like I was lost,” the young woman shared after the service. “I felt like I was going to give up. I wanted to give up... this was my last place, my last chance to finally be free, to not be enslaved. And it was just an incredible feeling now, that I am now feeling peace, love, and freedom. And that’s why I came here, to get that freedom, get my authority back, my identity back.”

MORE THAN A SERVICE

Freedom Night was fast-paced. Most of what has been described above took place within the first twenty-three minutes of the livestream—a testament to how quickly the Spirit of the Lord began to manifest in the service. The two hours that followed positioned those in attendance to step into a new level of faith. The power of God continued to manifest through prophecy, healing, and deliverance, but in the midst of it all, there was a clear apostolic grace flowing. Not only was the message on the liberty of the Spirit powerful, but the exhortations released were also nods to the life-changing revelation that had been released in the prayer meeting the evening prior.



The service had been intentionally orchestrated to help congregants grasp the revelation and run with it as well. Deep into the service, Apostle Ed pulled the attention back to the wheelchairs, walkers, and other mobility devices on the platform. “Some of these things that we bring back from the crusades—it’s not that we want to carry stuff, but this is a reminder that Jesus is a healer. A deliverer. And this is a visual to encourage someone’s faith that if you need healing tonight, you can be healed,” he said. “...Like these people that were in the wheelchairs started walking. If God can raise the crippled to walk, what about you? What about me?”

This wasn’t only a service. It was a gate into a new era. World Healing Church’s mission begins by declaring the North Texas assembly to be a place of transformation. Over the last three months, this has been true for the attendees, but also for the leaders and the congregation overall. The corporate identity and functionality have shifted. The restoration of the altar of prayer has led to increased power, more team ministry, and the exercise of the gifts of the Holy Spirit throughout the congregation, as opposed to only on the platform. There have been observable changes in the ministries of staff clergy, with powerful corporate moments involving Associate Pastor David Ahart and young adult minister Ronnie Lampkin being experienced since the local church stepped into this season of the renewal of the Holy Spirit on Sunday, May 17th.

Reflecting on the release of revelation that happened during the Thursday evening prayer meeting, Apostle Ed shared, “I’ve been in ministry for a long time. But what happened to me yesterday—I was telling them—changed everything in my life and ministry. You have not seen Ed Citronnelli yet. Get ready. I’m about to manifest. I’m expecting things. And I learned about the power of expectation.”

It was a Word of the Lord that tied all the previous words together. Nearly every week since the Fanning the Flame prayer meetings were added, they have proven to be a training ground for prophetic intercession and an incubator for prophecy. Scripture declares that “*we know in part and we prophesy in part.*” (1 Corinthians 13:9) Over time, the parts expressed in the prayer meetings have come together to paint an image of end-time revival that is not only spectacular, but is also imminently approaching. The light of the revelation of the Word of God about

expectation lands in this context with explosive implications. Not only does it reaffirm what has already been said declaratively, but it calls believers back to a core component of the apostolic message: faith.

Filled with that faith, as the service closed, Apostle Ed stood in the gate of the month of August and made prophetic decrees that thrust the lives of the attendees forward. The month of new beginnings was a few hours away, but many in the room were already standing in the middle of their fresh start. They had been touched by the Spirit of the Lord and equipped by the teaching of the Word. All in attendance had been given a white handkerchief as a point of contact for their faith. They weren’t leaving waving white flags of surrender to the enemy, but victory in Jesus. Their freedom had come.
